  - Identifying Class for Recording
- Digital Recorder
- Windows Movie Maker(optional)
- Digital Editing Software(optional)
  - WMA to MP3

### Different Methods Different Results

#### • Adding Item

- Advantages
  - Allows students to save file outside of blackboard that can be copied to a mp3 player or CD.
- Disadvantages
  - Students can give these recordings to other students and no control after downloading.

#### Adding Audio

- Advantages
  - Audio plays only when students are logged into blackboard.
  - Instructor has control over audio distribution.
- Disadvantages
  - Students are limited in the access to the material outside of Blackboard.

## Why podcast?

- Distance Education
  - For online and hybrid course students can sit in a virtual lecture.
- Student Absence
  - For those students that miss a lecture then they will have an additional way to review other than reading the book.

#### Teacher Absence

- Sick
  - Should an Instructor call in sick this allows students to still maintain their place in lecture so a day is not lost.
- Weather
  - The same as for when a teacher is out sick

### Why Podcast?

 Allows you to hear your own lecture to changes things up for the students

- Can be utilized with Power Points to provide a new method of Delivering Information
  - Also with appropriate editing software can link the PowerPoint to the audio and create a video students can watch
